

Dennis D. Steinauer

Dennis D. Steinauer is a senior computer scientist with the U.S. National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), where he serves as deputy chief of the Computer Security Division. He has led several technical and standards activities in the field of information security, including security standards for the Portable Operating System for Computer Environments (POSIX) and development of concepts, techniques, and organization for computer security incident response. He was instrumental in the creation of the international Forum of Incident Response and Security Teams (FIRST). He has served on several interagency committees and task forces, including President Clinton's Health Care Reform Task Force (focusing on privacy and security issues), the Privacy Working Group and Security Issues Forum of the Information Infrastructure Task Force, co-chair of the Privacy and Security Working Group of the interagency Committee on Computers, Information, and Communications, and the Security Subcommittee of the interagency CIO Council.

Before joining NIST, Mr. Steinauer worked several years as a data security consultant. Earlier in his career, he was responsible for data security of the General Electric Mark III computer services network. As an officer in the U.S. Navy, he served as a program manager on the Joint Strategic Target Planning Staff.

Mr. Steinauer has a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering from Northwestern University and has done graduate work in computer science and management. He has been actively involved in several professional activities and is a frequent speaker on subjects relating to computers and information security. Mr. Steinauer has served as vice-chair of the Special Interest Group on Security, Auditing, and Control (SIGSAC) of the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), president of the National Capital Area Chapter EDP Auditors Association, and national secretary, Information Systems Security Association (ISSA). He received the 1990 *Federal 100* award from Federal Computer Week for his contributions to information technology management in the Federal Government. Mr. Steinauer has held professional certifications as a Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) and a Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP). He is also an avid runner.
