

Christoph F. Mecklenbräuer received the Dr.-Ing. degree in Electrical Engineering from Ruhr-University of Bochum in 1998. His doctoral thesis on array signal processing was awarded with the Gert Massenbergr-Prize. He was a guest scientist at IST, Lisbon, Portugal, at Carnegie Mellon University, Pittsburgh, USA, at Queensland University of Technology, Brisbane, Australia, and at the SACLANT Research Centre, La Spezia, Italy. He worked for the Mobile Networks Radio department of Siemens AG and participated in the MAST3/ROBLINKS and ACTS/FAMES frameworks. He was a delegate to the Third Generation Partnership Project and engaged in the standardisation of the radio access network for UMTS. He has joined FTW, in 2000. He has (co-)authored around 40 papers and communications in international journals and conferences and holds several patents on mobile radio technology.
